Emergency condition occurred. PVWC's Harrison Avenue elevated water storage tank in Lodi, New Jersey (the "Harrison Avenue Tank") began experiencing leaks at a rate which required a significant number of emergency interim periodic welding repairs until the existing tank could be taken out of service and drained. Failure to aggressively repair

these emergency leaks as soon as they occurred would have

compromised the structural integrity of the existing tank (which was located in a residential area) which, in turn, could have led to a tank

failure and potentially catastrophic release of stored water.
